Volunteer Positions Available

Long-Term Volunteers (Program Directors) oversee LtN program implementation, help with LtN curriculum development, assist with metrics and evaluation, provide logistical support for Team Trips, create content for our website and social media channels and assist in volunteer recruitment. The ideal candidate should have strong Spanish skills and be a recent college graduate.

Bocas del Toro, Panama: PDs in Panama must commit for a minimum of 3 months (ideally 6+ months). Applications must be filled through the LtN website.

Short-Term Volunteers (Interns) play an integral role in the planning and execution of our daily programs & activities. Short-term volunteers are college-aged and ready to utilize their energy, enthusiasm, and skill-set to contribute to the on-going development of LtNs programs.

Bocas del Toro, Panama: can apply through our website for a 1 to 3-month session. Start and end dates are more flexible but we ask for a minimum 4-week commitment.
